

# 2015 Annual Report



#### **Editorial**

We would like to close 2015 by expressing our gratitude for your participation and support which has helped improve children's health across the world.

Thirteen projects in 2015 have benefited thousands of children in 4 continents and 9 countries from Syria to Latin America, through Spain and Africa, as detailed in our annual report.

In line with our mission, we have supported building health centers, financing food grants and nutrition packs in Spain, purchasing anti-malaria kits in Africa and shipping milk for infants to refugee camps in Syria.

We are very pleased with the impact on society. An increasing number of persons and entities are working with our projects, volunteering, proposing new initiatives or making donations.

One of the most remarkable initiatives in 2015 has been the Nuria García Foundation Junior Tennis Circuit, set up with the aim of fund raising and promoting awareness among young tennis players about the importance of helping children in need in their environment.

Thanks to your help in 2015, the Foundation has increased its support to thousands of children, transforming their present and future.



### **Projects in Spain**

## Building of the day care center at Hospital Sant Joan de Déu – Working with the family of Victoria Malaret

Donation:€30,000 over 2 years

The Hospital Sant Joan de Déu needed a new day care center to treat an increasing number of children with cancer, offering better equipment, space and intimacy conditions for the families. It is predicted that 1602 young patients will use the facilities in 2016.

### Food grants in Gavà and Castelldefels – Working with local social services and La Caixa Foundation

Donation: €10,000

The Foundation has signed agreements with local councils to co-finance food grants, making it possible for over 50 pupils to eat in the school canteen every day, in some cases their only meal of the day.



#### **Projects in Spain**

## Donation to purchase children's food – Working with Cáritas

Donation: €4,800

The Foundation has financed the purchase of food for children, which has been added to the food parcels that Cáritas has distributed to 120 families, helping more than 90 children under the age of two. This donation covers the purchase for 2015.

## Nutrition for children in need in L'Hospitalet de Llobregat (Barcelona) - Working with AEMA SSCL

Donation: €4,200

AEMA is an organization that manages a refuge and two open centers in L'Hospitalet de LLobregat (Barcelona). The Foundation finances a year of healthy meals for children of families in difficult financial situation. These children attend the centers after school to receive help with their schoolwork and a meal.



#### **Projects in Africa**

## Nutrition and education of shepherd children in Kenya - Working with the África Digna Foundation

Donation: €5,000

Ninety shepherd children in northern Kenya need nutritional and educational support. The Foundation, working with the NGO Africa Digna, finances one meal and two hours of class a day for one year. The aim is to reduce the high level of malnutrition and illiteracy among shepherd children in the Samburu communities in northern Kenya.

### Saving 75 children's lives in Madagascar – Working with Malaria 40 and Covidec

Donation: €3,000

The Foundation and the NGO Malaria40 strive to save the lives of children affected by malaria. Most of the beneficiaries are children under the age of five, since child mortality at this age in Madagascar is as high as 78,8%. €40 buys anti-malaria medication, mosquito nets, serum and access to blood transfusions, saving the life of a child.



### **Projects in Africa**

### Water treatment at Monavebe Hospital, Cameroon – Working with the Recover Foundation

Donation: €10,000

The hospital's water supply circuit was in poor condition and was contaminating the water of the hospital. The circuit has been checked over, a new filtering system installed with chlorination and the tank has been cleaned. The project helps 15,320 persons although 100,000 people have felt an indirect benefit.

## Construction of a well in the South of Madgascar – Working with Covide-AMVE

Donation: €1,000

Working with the project Malaria40, the Foundation is financing digging a well in the south of the island. The well is located in the school grounds and will benefit the school itself and 130 families living nearby with no access to drinking water.



#### **Project in Latin America**

## A new health center in Nicaragua, "Centro Nuria García" - Working with TFWA and Asociación Fabretto

Donation: €36,000

Thanks to a subsidy from the Tax Free World Association, the Foundation is financing the construction of a health center to support women and children in the area of Cusmapa. Locally, the Fabretto Association is in charge of the building work and follow-up in San José de Cusmapa.

Besides medical attention, the center will offer training in looking after your own health, prevention of malnutrition and early stimulation for children. Starting at the end of 2015, the first beneficiaries will be 60 women and 105 children aged from 0 to 6 years old.

This is the first health center to be given Nuria's name, as the soul of our Foundation. In 2016, another clinic named after her will be refurbished in Nepal thanks to renewed support from TFWA.

#### Other joint projects

## Support for Syrian refugees – Working with the Mensajeros de la Paz Foundation

Donation: €4,300

The Foundation has sent two pallets of powdered milk to infants of families in Syrian refugee camps.

#### For Nepal – Working with Unicef

Donation: €250

The benefit of a sale during a school fair was donated to Unicef. It represented our modest contribution to help the population of Nepal after the earthquake.

## Purchase of stretchers for a hospital of Senegal - Working with the Gabriel Navarro Foundation

Donation: €200

Volunteer doctors go to operate in a small hopsital in Senegal every year. They were lacking basic equipment, starting with stretchers for sick children.

### Charity race against malnutrition and hunger in Argentina—Working with the Comparte Foundation

Donation: €500

The Foundation helped to run the race organized by Comparte, with volunteers and a donation to buy participants' T-shirts. Money made by the race has been used for nutrition projects in Tucumán, Argentina.


