



Who we are

The Nuria García Foundation is an independant organisation working for children around the world.

In 2016, we were able to help several thousand children across the globe through our work and the work of our partners.

An important change in 2016 was to broaden our statutes in order to include children's education in the Foundation's mission – in addition to assisting global health and nutrition projects. Education is vital for ensuring a decent and happier future.

We organised more awareness-raising events. Friends of the Foundation always join in, and the young athletes in our region are a little more aware of the chance to help, by taking part in the Nuria García Junior Tennis Circuit.



Where we work

We operate across five continents to generate real change in children's lives. In Spain, we work on projects focusing on nutrition and hygiene. On an international level, we launch new health and education programmes in different countries every year in order to reach children in urgent need of assistance. In 2016, we were present in eight countries with projects in different geographic regions.



The work of the Foundation around the world

In 2016, the Fundación supported 12 projects, donating 94,798 euros. Eight of these projects were undertaken in Asia, Africa and Latin America.

Nutrition and building healthcare centres

We fight to give all children access to the food and nutrients they need to be healthy. We have also financed the construction of health centres for children and their families in several countries.

Ethiopia (Save the Children)

Highly nutritious food was distributed to cover the needs of children and their families suffering from a food emergency. This situation affects about 10 million people, 435.000 of them are children diagnosed with severe malnutrition.

Donation: 7.000€

Refugee camps in Greece

Save the Children has distributed, with our donation, vital supplies to cover the needs of 450 children and 530 pregnant women in 6 different camps of the north of Greece. These families are fleeing war and extreme poverty.

Donation: 8.000€



Gambia (Nutrición sin fronteras)

The nutrition centres in Gambia built by Nutrición sin fronteras (Nutrition Without Borders) care for malnourished children, found whilst combing the local villages. They feed them and train mothers in maintaining kitchen gardens.

Donation: 10.000€

Honduras (Centro Cultural Hibueras)

Together with the local population, CCH is building a maternal and child health centre in the Pacayal region, where there is no medical assistance available less than one hour's walk away. This project ensures medical follow-up and new working opportunities.

Donation: 8.000€

Nepal (Fundación Okume AZ - TFWA)

In a residence for the elderly, the Fundación Okume AZ has equipped one floor as a clinic in order to treat the children from the nearby orphanage, the elderly people in the residence and the entire neighbourhood community free of charge.

Donation: 15.000€

Education

As well as looking after children's health, we want to offer them the opportunity to build a better future.

Kenya (Fundación África Digna)

For a third year, we have financed the education and nutrition of 110 young Samburu shepherds. They receive two hours of schooling and a dinner upon finishing their day with the flock.

Donation: 6.700€



Kenía (Kakrigu Primary School)

After visiting the Mfangano school, the Trust decided to fund several infrastructure improvement works to support the education of 350 primary school-age children.

Donation: 1.767€

Safe wells for drinking water

Access to drinking water continues to be one of the major problems on the planet. Furthermore, in the Kolda region, 35% of the infant mortality rate is due to diarrhoea or intestinal infections caused by bacteria from contaminated drinking water. The wells do not have adequate protection, become contaminated and are dangerous. Every year, one or two children drown.

Senegal (Fundación Guné)

10 wells are safer and, now that they are protected, prevent children and animals from falling in. Over 200 families have a better quality of life.

Donation: 7.000€



The work of the Foundation in Spain

The Foundation is also concerned with children closer to home: in our city and in our country. In Spain, 1 in 3 children live below the poverty line.

Nutrition and hygiene

In 2016, a total of €31,331 went to several nutrition programmes for children and young people, and towards purchasing hygiene products for babies.



#INVULNERABLES (Fundaciones Rosa Oriol y FCB - Obra Social La Caixa)

This programme fights against poverty, aiming at extremely vulnerable children and families in Catalonia. It responds to basic needs, offering comprehensive support to the family and guidance for parents. The Foundation has bought hygiene products for children aged 0-3.

Donation: 10.095€

Rebost (Fundación Roure)

The “Rebost” (“pantry”) helps 370 people in a very precarious situation (169 children) from the neighbourhood of Ciutat Vella in Barcelona, offering them access to food and hygiene products.

Donation: 11.000€

Meal grants (Castelldefels Council)

The Foundation is once again collaborating with the Council to co-finance school meal grants for 16 pupils from families in a precarious economic situation.

Donation: 5.136€

#MenjarsallInsti (Gavà Red Cross)

At secondary education level (ESO), pupils lose the right to a school meal grant from the Generalitat. But in many cases, the family of the young person continues to require this support for daily food. The Red Cross identifies risk situations and facilitates the child’s access to food inside and outside of school (with cards loaded for non-school periods).

Donation: 5.000€

Raising awareness and events

Our vocation is to raise local awareness of the reality of many children who do not have access to proper education or nutrition, thereby affecting their physical and intellectual growth.

Raising awareness in Spain

The Foundation organised a charity dinner with 260 guests and held several solidarity markets. It has also participated in local festivals such as Sant Jordi. Every year, the Tennis 66 team and the Andrés Gimeno Tennis Club organise the Nuria García Foundation Junior Tennis Circuit. These are opportunities to publicise the work of the Foundation and raise awareness among local children.



Raising awareness in the USA

Through its contacts with two Foundations in the United States, Nandansons and Kanak&Prabha Golia Foundations, the Trust has collected donations for the nutrition programme for orphans from Honduras, managed by the Fundación Nuestros Pequeños Hermanos. The American foundations have donated a total of 10,000 USD directly to this programme.
