

In addition, we have carried out 18 new projects: 13 in health and nutrition, of which 7 have been of urgent aid due to the pandemic, and 5 in education and infrastructure in Spain, Africa and Latin America, benefiting approximately 3,200 children. We have also made personal care product donations for children in Sant Joan de Déu Hospital with 3 associations, and hand sanitizers and children's face masks in Spain and Uganda.

We would like to make a special mention to the families who have suffered the loss of loved ones due to COVID-19.

Finally, we want to thank you all. Without your donations, your solidarity purchases and your help, these projects would not have been possible.



Equine Therapy program for children with ASD Baix Llobregat

With ISTEA Association

The impact of confinement on children with autism has directly affected most cases. Many of the families with young people affected by this type of disorder are in a precarious situation and without resources to be able to offer them special education. The experience of facing a highly "open" diagnosis presents the need to require great involvement from various contexts, including at home, school, therapeutic, medical and social levels.

This year we have decided to cooperate in a special project with ISTEA Association, created and endorsed by a group of ASD specialist psychologists who work voluntarily with them. Our work consists of granting and satisfying the demand of families and individuals with ASD, as well as promoting knowledge, participation, support and social integration. With this program, equine therapy sessions will be held for vulnerable children suffering from an autism spectrum disorder.

This project provides 30 children between the ages of 4 and 18 with tools that allow them to have a positive development during the school year.











Social care for children from single-mother families Barcelona

With Teresa Gallifa Foundation

The Nuria García Foundation has decided to collaborate with the Teresa Gallifa Foundation to cover the basic needs of children from single-mother families, who are in a situation of extreme vulnerability. We want to promote the social inclusion of these mothers or pregnant women so that they have the necessary support through a resource bank at their disposal.

Many of the mothers who come to the Centre for Attention to Maternal Single Parent Families have lost their jobs and are living in sheltered flats. Given this reality, care and help through donations of basic necessities such as food, personal hygiene products and clothing for 50 children from single-mother families is more necessary than ever.







Pediatric stroke, physiotherapy and pedagogy for minors Lérida

With Ictus Foundation

Spain detects 120 cases of stroke in minors each year, making it one of the top ten causes of infant mortality.

This year we collaborate with the Ictus Foundation project with the aim of rehabilitating children who have suffered a stroke, making the disease known and promoting their research at Lleida Hospital. By participating in this program, we will help 40 children affected by this disease in the Paediatric Physiotherapy Unit of Lleida, which do not have the

financial means to carry out post-hospital treatment.

With the help of physiotherapy and therapeutic neurorehabilitation, fun therapy with virtual reality games, many manage to learn to walk, talk or eat autonomously. To do this, we will provide material for the stroke and physiotherapy unit (psychomotor track, posture wedges, crawler and balance, virtual reality, etc.) which will help reduce the impact of the disease and improve the quality of life of these children.

Dining at home scholarships Madrid

With Educo Foundation

In coordination with social entities and with the Educo Foundation, families that were already in a precarious situation were identified during the pandemic.

With the project called "Dining at Home

Scholarships" we ensure that 40 children between the ages of 3 and 11 continue to receive a healthy diet despite the financial difficulties of their families and the closure of schools for 20 days.











Dining scholarships for municipal nurseries Viladecans

With Viladecans City Council

In the final stage of the 2019–2020 school year, marked by the closure of face-to-face activity in educational centers, the students of the Kindergarten of Viladecans Municipal Schools and of the nursery and primary schools that had a dining scholarship were left without any recourse due to the pandemic. Being enrolled in a municipal school ensured a main meal for all of them, so it was essential to focus our help on providing them with a healthy diet.

The contribution that has been made with the Viladecans City Council located in Baix Llobregat, consists of access to dining scholarships for 48 children from municipal nurseries between the months of March to July 2020, while the centres were closed. The purpose is to facilitate access to these centres for families with less income, helping the children who need it most.











Children's dining scholarships Gavà

With City Council of Gavà

The Foundation collaborates once again with the Gavà City Council located in Baix Llobregat, to provide financial assistance for children who have been left in a state of vulnerability greater than or equal to

the one they suffered from the pandemic. For this reason, up to 100% of the dining scholarships for the needlest children are complemented.











Food and school supplies for children Sant Boi de Llobregat

With Marianao Foundation

With the mission of promoting the personal and community development of those people who suffer from precarious situations, we wanted to participate in a nutritional care program for children together with Marianao Foundation during the 6 months of confinement.

The project consists of the distribution of food and school supplies to approximately 25 families with children between the ages of 3 and 12, so that they can go to school and dine under the same conditions as the rest of their classmates.















Food and hygiene products for families Madrid

With Pan y Peces Foundation

Thanks to the excellent team of volunteers from Pan y Peces Foundation, an organization that helps more than 700 families without resources, we have been This aid arrives monthly and is collected able to help 36 children for 3 months, making sure that all their food and hygiene needs are covered through the distribution of food and a donation of

Providing food to the Solidarity Commissary Barcelona

With Roure Foundation

We continue to collaborate with the Solidary Food Pantry, a project carried out with Roure Foundation in its food bank located in the Old Town of Barcelona. The objective is to respond to food needs and guarantee essential food for people at risk of social exclusion.

The Solidarity Commissary project seeks to optimize resources, expand product

diversification, avoid food waste and duplications that lead to inequalities, and reach more people in need. This resource allows families to choose the foods they need for healthy nutrition and thus not be passive recipients of a batch of food. The Nuria García Foundation has contributed 3.390 litres of milk for 350 children and their families.









Food and basic necessities for families San Blas, Madrid

With Achalay Association

Achalay Association, is focused on the monthly delivery of food and necessities risk of social exclusion in the San Blas neighborhood, Madrid.

In our first distribution we have provided help to buy 200 family lots benefiting 50 families, of which 101 are children, over 3



Nutrition and education of shepherd children Kenya

With África Digna Foundation

It is the fourth year that we collaborate with the "Lchekuti, shepherd children" program in Kenya together with Africa Digna Foundation. This project promotes a dignified life for children from 6 to 16 years of age by carrying out educational and nutritional interventions of impact in the Samburu communities of Barsaloi, Lodokume, Lowa, Lulu, Mabati, Nairimirimo, Opiroi and Raraiti.

For these communities, located in northern
Kenya, herding is their main economic activity. For cultural reasons, Samburu and offer a sum of families choose the smartest boy or girl in their family to look after the livestock.

Because these shepherd children work all day, they do not have the opportunity

to go to school and they feed exclusively on milk and tea. For this reason, they are children who cannot read or write, with a high risk of social exclusion and with a considerable degree of malnutrition.

We have ensured that Kenyan shepherd children have access to two hours of daily education from Monday to Friday, a balanced meal at the end of classes each day and, at the end of each study term, parents will be convened to communicate the results of their children in their studies and offer a meal to all. Our contribution will last for 2 school years, until 2022, in four different centres and will help about 280 children.









Construction and equipment of Kikaya School Uganda


With Babies Uganda Association

At the beginning of 2018 in the Kikaya area, Uganda, children did not have any quality schools and had to get up at 5:30 in the morning to cross the lake to be able to get to their classes on time. For this reason, many of them were not in school and, due to the high poverty rate of the families in the area, Babies Uganda decided to make a school that all children could attend.

Following our 2018 project with Babies Uganda at Kikaya House, our Foundation hasfunded the construction and furnishing

of a new bedroom for 75 children between 5 and 14 years old at Kikaya School. It will allow to clear a new classroom for the use of the smallest children, who are very many, as well as to enable the old room that they used as a bedroom to become a library for all. We want to maintain a quality education, adapting to the needs that students have year after year because of the dramatic reality that thousands of Ugandan children experience who suffer from poverty, abandonment, the death of a parent, or even abuse or illness.

Fight against maternal and child malnutrition Mozambique

With IBO Foundation

Difficulties in accessing food and food insecurity in Mozambique are fundamental factors that hinder local development processes. In April 2019, Cyclone Kenneth struck the coastal area of the Cabo Delgado province, directly affecting the IBO island, Mozambique. Schools, Health Centres and basic infrastructure suffered very serious damage, as were the houses of thousands of people who live on the island. Currently 67,500 children suffer from food insecurity and are exposed to a host of deadly diseases such as malaria or typhus.

This year, part of our aid will go to the IBO Nutritional Support Centre (CANI), with the aim of fighting maternal and child malnutrition and alleviating its causes and consequences for 12 months. We want to contribute to the socioeconomic development of IBO and to the improvement of the precarious situation in which its inhabitants find themselves. We will help approximately 300 children under the age of 5 and 200 pregnant women or mothers with nursing children.

Prevention and treatment against malaria Cameroon


With Recover Foundation

We collaborate once again with Recover Foundation, this year with a malaria prevention and treatment program in Cameroon, which aims to diagnose and treat malaria for children in 8 schools.

According to the World Health Organization, half of the world's population is at risk of contracting malaria, but Cameroon is above 80% of that probability. The highest at risk of being affected are children and pregnant women, since malaria is a disease that causes a high

number of abortions, premature births and high neonatal mortality.

The project will subsidize diagnostic tests, hospitalization costs for severe cases of malaria and treatment for such cases to 970 children in the region, including the distribution of mosquito nets among families in need. Information days will also be given to the parents of the students to improve the prevention of the disease, all during a period of 12 months.

Construction of a nursery school Senegal

With Guné Foundation

This is the third project that we carry out can exceed 40 degrees in the dry season with Guné Foundation in the construction of schools to improve the education of children living in the Kolda region, Senegal. This year our aid goes to the construction of an educational building with four bathrooms in the Soussoutou region.

In many villages in the Kolda region, schools do not have adequate infrastructure to accommodate children. In many cases they are made of straw and logs, considering that temperatures and there is not enough protection during the rainy season. This situation causes high absenteeism and low school performance.

We will guarantee an equitable and high-quality education, promoting learning opportunities in Senegal. With the construction of the new classroom, 70 children will be able to use the new classroom and the new bathrooms will benefit 200 children.









Expansion of the inclusive school in Monze Zambia

With Juan Ciudad NGDO

Unfortunately, 86% of the Zambian population lives below the poverty line. It is necessary to provide decent levels of health and social well-being to people who live in disadvantaged regions of the world and who lack access to essential services such as education.

The Nuria García Foundation has collaborated since 2019 in the construction of the first inclusive school in Monze, Zambia, together with Juan Ciudad NGDO. The final objective of this project is the

adaptation of 12 classes equipped with an inclusive education program, we have already participated in the construction of 1 classroom and a library with capacity for 200 children.

Our new contribution has gone towards the construction of the kitchen and bathrooms. These areas of the school are very necessary for students to have decent living and schooling conditions. 3,200 children will be able to attend school thanks to the improvements made!

Improving the Gambasse school Guinea-Bissau



Health and nutrition program Cuzco

With Amantaní Association

The Cuzco Family Police Station, the Family Courts and the SPU (Special Protection Unit of the MIMP) continuously receive children under family vulnerability conditions due to the temporary or permanent incapacity of the family to care for them. These children need a home from a very young age that can meet their nutritional, health, emotional, material and educational needs in the most familiar environment possible. Therefore, the entities turn directly to the Amantaní Association shelter so that they receive the best possible care.


Since 2019, we have collaborated with

them in favour of children's rights in their foster home in the city of Cuzco, Peru. We want to continue helping minors at social risk or parental vulnerability and, above all, raising awareness about the precarious situation of children in this country. Our purpose is to enable the detection and prevention of diseases, as well as the nutritional care and well-being of 60 babies, children and adolescents in the home in Cuzco. Children who come from an unstable family environment need more love, attention and affection than those who have been fortunate to be born in a normalized and stable family environment.

Donations for children of Sant Joan de Déu Hospital













